## BASICS

Players take turns to play a card from their hand onto the table, then place a chip on an appropriate square. Make straight lines of 4 or more chips to score points.



Line Length	4	5	6	7	8
Point Value	1	2	3	4	5

## SET UP



Deal seven cards, and about 25 chips (of a unique color) to each player.



Remaining cards form a draw pile.



Left of the dealer starts.



Take turns clockwise.

## DETAILS



When playing a 'character card', read it aloud, then place a chip on an empty square in that character's section of the board.

E.g. a card featuring a pirate in the text can be played on any empty 'Pirates' square.



Magic cards allow the player to place a chip on any empty square.



When playing a pick up card, pick up the indicated number of cards, then take another turn.



Pick up from the draw pile when you have less than 7 cards.



If a card features two characters in the text, place a chip in either character's square.



Keep playing until players run out of cards. Most points at the end, wins!

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
